

Postdoctoral positions in Astrophysics and Cosmology

The Astrophysics and Cosmology team in Ben-Gurion University (BGU) invites applications for two joint postdoctoral fellowships, with professors Yuri Lyubarsky and Uri Keshet.

The planned research involves topics in high energy astrophysics, plasma astrophysics, cosmology, and large scale structure. The work will include analytic, computational, or phenomenological aspects, depending on the applicant: relevant experience is necessary.

Each fellowship is for a period of 2+1 years, to begin in 2017 or sooner. Applicants should send their CV, list of publications, and description of previous research (up to 3 pages), and arrange for at least two letters of reference to be sent directly, to astro@bgu.ac.il.

BGU is a public research, 20,000 student University situated in Be'er Sheva, Israel: a city of population 200,000, about an hour by bus or train from Tel Aviv. Present faculty in Astrophysics and Cosmology include Eichler, Gedalin, Keshet, Lyubarsky, and Zitrin, and senior staff scientists Golbraikh and Griv.
