THE DANISH-ISRAELI STUDY FOUNDATION IN MEMORY OF JOSEF AND REGINE NACHEMSOHN

In accordance with the testamentary provisions of the late David B. Nachemsohn, antique dealer, the Foundation was established in Memory of David B. Nachemsohn's parents, Josef and Regine Nachemsohn.

The purpose of the Foundation is, in accordance with the instrument of foundation of 21 April 1992, to grant scholarships to Danish students for studies at universities and other institutions of higher education in Israel, and to Israeli students for studies at universities and other institutions of higher education in Denmark.

The Foundation expects to be able to grant scholarships of varying amount of money for the university year following this announcement.

Application from a Danish citizen with permanent residence in Israel, referring to studies in Israel or in Denmark, cannot be accepted as the object of the Foundation is exchange of Israeli students. Application from an Israeli citizen with permanent residence in Denmark referring to studies in Israel is also excluded.

It is quite seldom that the Foundation economical can support education as PhD, post-doc or etcetera.

The closing date for applications is **31. December 2010**. Replies to applications will be sent in Spring of 2011.
